Requirements:

All applicants must complete in an essay for the following information.

- **Irish Dance**-Please list in detail your experience and goals in Irish Dance. Listing of achievements in competition, leadership in your school assisting with younger student instruction, activist for the awareness of Irish Dance should all be included.
- **Age Requirement**-This process is open to current High School or College Students. Please provide your current High School information, and College (and previous High School).
- **Community Volunteer Service**-Describe in details how you are involved in your community through volunteer efforts. List any leadership roles and achievements.
- **Goals**-What would you change to make the world better? What are your college goals, or career goals?
- **Active Dancer Status**-Recipient must be a current year Michigan Feis Competitor to be eligible for receiving this award.
